Situated 560 metres above sea level on the Deccan Plateau at the confluence of the Mula and Mutha rivers, Pune city is the administrative capital of Pune district.

Climate

Pune has a tropical wet and dry climate with average temperatures ranging between 20 to 28 °C (68 to 82 °F).

Winter begins in November; November in particular is referred to as the Rosy Cold (literal translation) (Marathi: गुलाबीथंडी). The daytime temperature hovers around 28 °C (82 °F) while night temperature is below 10 °C (50 °F) for most of December and January, often dropping to 5 to 6 °C.
