12.	<b>STANDARD OF PASSING</b>	The assessment of the student for each examination is done based on relative performance. Minimum Grade Point (GP) is 10 corresponding to O ( outstanding). For all courses, a student is required to pass both internal (continuous assessment) and external examination(term end examination) separately with a minimum Grade point of 4 corresponding to Grade P. Students securing less than 40% absolute marks in each head of passing will be declared FAIL. The University awards a certificate to the student who has achieved a minimum CGPA of 4 out of maximum of 10 CGPA for the programme.		
13.	<b>AWARD OF DEGREE/ DIPLOMA/ CERTIFICATE</b>	Certificate in Asian Legal Studies will be awarded at the completion of the course by taking into consideration the performance in the examination after obtaining minimum 4.00 CGPA out of 10 CGPA.
