Insolvency, Bankruptcy and Private Equity: Mr. Sunder Korivi

The session of Insolvency, bankruptcy and Private Equity by Mr. Sunder Korivi was conducted for the IV and V Year students of BA and BBA LLB, II and III Year of LLB and LLM. Sir gave a brief introduction to the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016, before proceeding to a discussion on the record highs of Private Equity in 2017.

Growing Concerns with reference to GST: Dr. Sudipta Chakraborty.

The session on Growing Concerns of GST was organized on 15th March, 2018 for the IV Year students of BA and BBA LLB and II Year students of LLB. The honourable speaker initiated the lecture by shedding light on the fundamental concepts of direct and indirect taxes and their immediate advantages and disadvantages. She also touched upon excise and customs duties and then proceeded to give a detailed understanding on the three kinds of GST taxes: CGST, SGST AND IGST. Dr. Chakraborty further spoke about how GST solidifies the concept of one nation, one tax, which helps in reducing the disparity in business among all the states in the country. She mentioned how GST has transformed into a destination-based tax, with that state earning the tax on goods from where it is sold. The distinguished lecturer educated the students about the interpretation of this near-controversial tax system and listed the most

prominent changes under GST, further addressing the disputable issues surrounding it.
